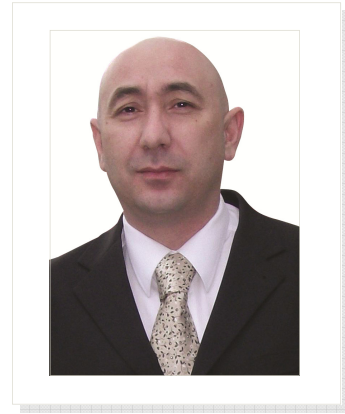

## BROXBOURNE COUNCIL TAX FROZEN

## £3M INVESTMENT IN GRUNDY PARK
