As the Bank is a working institution, it is not possible for members of the public to look around the building in Threadneedle Street. The only areas of the Threadneedle Street building accessible to the public are the museum and the banking counter where you can exchange out-of-date Bank of England notes. No other area of the Bank of England is open to the public. The audio-visual presentation 'The Bank of England, Past and Present' covers some of the more interesting architectural aspects of the building, as well as touching on the Bank's role and responsibilities.
